

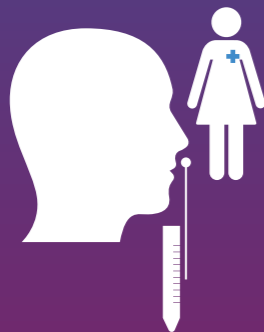
# Getting Your COVID-19 PCR Test for Travel.



**1** Visit the preferred testing location you selected when you registered for your test. Take note of the visiting date and hours of the selected location. You can find all location addresses and operating dates and times at: [clearme.ca/qantas](https://clearme.ca/qantas).



**2** Upon arrival, you will be asked for your your test confirmation **QR code** sent to you by email when you registered for your test. If you have not received a confirmation email, please contact [support@clearme.ca](mailto:support@clearme.ca) prior to visiting the test location. **Please bring your government issued photo ID to confirm your identity** (passport / driver's licenses / health card).



**3** A clinician or registered nurse will perform a test specimen collection using a nasopharyngeal swab. This process retrieves the specimen from the deep nasal cavity. Try to remain still and encourage young children to do the same during the process. The swabbing process is very short and relatively painless but may feel a bit uncomfortable for some. (Children 5 and under are not required to take this test)



**4** Your specimen will be sent for **PCR** test processing at an accredited laboratory and may take up to 24hrs. Test result notifications are sent to the email address used when you registered for your test. You may also click the **CHECK NOW** button located in your test confirmation email to access your test result once available.
